The 2016 Pinot Noir berries are grown in the heart of the Sta. Rita Hills region. Internationally known for its Pinot Noir-specific terrain, soil, and climate. With the cool Pacific air moderating the warm summer nights, grapes in this area in 2016 produced intense and full bodied wines that retained their natural acidity. Harvest began in early September, and the grapes were whole-cluster fermented for natural tannin depth and complexity.
