

ATLAS PEAK CABERNET SAUVIGNON



The 2016 Atlas Peak Cabernet Sauvignon is a strong, yet subdued wine. The sub-appellation is known for its extended growing season in deep volcanic soils that create a balance of new world richness and old world elegance.

The 2016 Cabernet was fermented at warm temperatures for three weeks for maximum flavor and color extraction, and aged for 20 months in approximately 65% new French oak.

The nose is bursting with crushed berry aromas, licorice, dried sage, finishing with a hint of rosemary. On the palate, the body is full with a mix of concentrated red fruit followed by firm and chewy tannins with a juicy finish. Drink now or hold through 2027.
